General information

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Safeguarding

All rowers, coaches, volunteers and staff have the right to participate and work in a non-violent, safe and respectful environment. Behaviour and actions that constitute harassment and abuse will not be tolerated. If concerns about harassment and abuse arise during the event, please contact the Safeguarding Officer Elias Kraus at the event or email e.kraus@regatta.de.

Team Info

The Team Info is in the administration building near the boating area and is the hub for all matters concerning your participation in the regatta. Here you can get your accreditation, book parking tickets or buy tickets for the Masters Party and Frühschoppen. In addition, you can check the current race results as well as make crew changes, withdraw entries and make your entries for mixed races at the self-service terminals.

Accreditation

Athletes, media representatives, exhibitors and partners of the 2023 Euro Masters Regatta must be accredited at the Team Info. Athletes must bring an official photo ID (identity card, passport) with them. A clearly legible copy of the document is sufficient in exceptional cases. The athlete's ID will be copied onto the accreditation. The accreditation must be always carried, also in the boat during the race, and may be checked at any time for security reasons. In addition, random checks will be carried out at the pontoons and no medal will be handed out without accreditation. Other persons such as coaches, friends and family, and spectators do not require any accreditation.











Arrival and driving on the premises

- **Towing vehicles** may drive onto the site with boat trailers and unload the trailers. After instruction, boat trailers can then be parked either behind the boat hangars or in the trailer parking area. These are marked on the location map. All towing vehicles must leave the venue within 30 minutes and can park in the grandstand car park. For this they need a parking ticket, which must be ordered in advance via the online entry system.
- **Unloaded boat trailers** are to be parked in the designated areas for boat trailers, not in the boat storage area. Exceptions may be approved if the boat storage areas are full.
- **Team/club vehicles/other vehicles** are not allowed on the venue but can park in the grandstand car park with direct access to the boating area. There is a charge for the car park, which is maintained by an external leaseholder. Parking permits are subject to a fee and must be ordered in advance via our online entry system to ensure smooth processing on site. A QR code is required to retrieve the parking pass on site (see next paragraph).
- Access routes and all escape and rescue routes must be kept clear at all times.
- On departure, the towing vehicles will be allowed onto the grounds in an orderly manner.

Boat storage

A large but limited number of boat racks are located near the in and out pontoons and at the rear of the boat hangars. The organising committee has allocated these boat racks to different boat classes. Teams are responsible for ensuring that their boats are securely fastened to the racks at all times and cannot be damaged by adverse weather conditions. Teams arriving with boats on trailers are advised to bring slings to secure the boats. Boats that cannot find space on the boat stands are to be stored on the boat trailers. Escape and rescue routes must be kept clear at all times. The paths under the canopies of the boat hangars are escape routes and as such must be kept clear at all times.

Camping

You will find our campsites as shown on the map directly at the entrance to the site. Upon arrival at the entrance to the campsite, please report directly to our camping team at the camping container. They will assign you a site according to your booking. Please bring the QR code with you, which you received shortly before the event, printed out or on your mobile phone. **Please note: No further camping bookings are possible, neither online nor on site!** Escape and rescue routes must be kept clear at all times on the campsites. Open fires are prohibited here as well as on the entire site. Cars must be parked in the grandstand car park if they are not registered for camping and are used for overnight stays. You will need a separate parking permit for this. You can book it online at https://max.m-start.de.

Results service

At the terminals in the team info but also on your own devices you can use our automated results service: <u>https://max.m-start.de</u>

For sustainability reasons, we do not print out start lists or results for participants.

Ergs

Ergs for training, warm-up and cool-down are provided by Concept2 and are in boat hangar 4. The equipment can be used during the opening hours of the team info.

Bicycle rental

Unfortunately, there are no bicycles for hire along the route.











Photo Box and Wall of Fame

On the grounds you can use a photo box to capture your memories on pictures. We have also set up a Wall of Fame for you, where you can find your names. Next to it you can see the flags of all participating nations. The best background for some beautiful photographic souvenirs!

Festival and fun

We offer you a regatta festival on Friday and Saturday afternoons with three live bands each. Please look out for the posters on the notice board. In addition to the festival, we offer a play area with a bouncy castle, climbing mountain and streamers on the other side of the administration building especially for the children.



Frühschoppen

On Sunday we will close the festival with a Bavarian-style Frühschoppen. From 9:00 hrs, the brass band Schöngeising will play, and we will serve white sausages and wheat beer in the festival tent. Advance ticket sales will take place until Saturday at the Team Info. On Sunday from 9:00 hrs you will find the sale directly at the tent.

Baggage drop

The Baggage Drop is located on the shore side of boat hangar 7 and is free of charge for athletes. The baggage drop is open on competition days from 30 minutes before the first start until 60 minutes after the last start. On training days, luggage can be handed in at the Team Info.

Swingin' Regatta Masters Party

On Saturday, the Swingin' Regatta Masters Regatta Party with a big band followed by a club night will take place. Advance ticket sales will take place until Saturday at the Team Info. On Saturday from 19:00 hrs you will find the sale directly at the tent.













Parking tickets

You will receive the pre-ordered parking tickets for the grandstand car park at the container in front of the car park as shown on the map. Please turn left directly after the exit from the B471 and follow the road.

For this purpose, you will receive a QR code by e-mail before the regatta, which you should bring with you on your mobile phone or printed out. This will speed up the process on site and avoid waiting times.

Shuttle Service

The regatta shuttle service will take you from the official team hotels and the S- and U-Bahn to the regatta site and back. Prerequisite: You must be in possession of a shuttle pass (orange). Participants who have booked their room through us will receive their shuttle pass at the reception of their hotel. All other participants must order the pass online in advance or buy it at the Team Info desk. The price depends on the duration of validity. Checks will be carried out on the buses.

Grandstand

Unfortunately, the large grandstand is closed for fire safety reasons. However, participants are allowed to pass through the grandstand from the car park and to use the toilets in the grandstands. Only staying and sitting in the grandstand is not permitted.

The natural grandstand on the opposite side is free to use and offers a perfect view of the finish line.

Drinking water

The water in Munich and at the regatta site is of the best drinking water quality. We recommend the use of refillable water bottles. On the regatta site, all taps in and on buildings are supplied with drinking water. Please note, however, that we do not recommend using the water basins at the campsites and in the toilet containers as drinking water due to the length of the pipes.











Catering

The regatta catering area is located around the festival area at the natural grandstand. Our landlord of the tent, Martin Burzlaff and his team, are looking forward to welcoming you. Around the festival area you will also find food trucks, drinks and a cocktail bar. Except on Sunday, the tent does not open for breakfast, but only from 10:00 hrs. The tent closes in the evening at around 20:00 hrs.

Payment methods

At the Team Info, you can pay in cash and by credit card. For online entries, you also have the option of using PayPal. In the tent and at most of the stands, payment by credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express) is possible. In exceptional cases, only cash payment is possible.











Regatta regulations

The provisions of the official regatta information shall apply at all times and with priority.

Withdrawals

If a team cannot or does not want to participate in an event, the team must withdraw at <u>https://max.m-start.de</u> as soon as possible. For reasons of fairness for the opponents and for teams that want to participate by late entry instead, the withdrawal should be done by 13:00 (CEST) of the day before the race, but at the latest two hours before the start time of the first heat of the respective event.

Bow numbers

All boats must be provided with bow numbers. These will be handed out in the Team Info at the earliest one hour before the race and will be collected again at the jetties after the races.

Late entries

Late entries are still possible after the entry deadline. However, late entries will only be accepted in heats in which there is still space. No new heats will be opened. However, this also means that the last heat of an event must still have space. The regatta fee will be doubled. Late entries will always be seeded in the last heat against the youngest rowers in an age category. Late entries are possible until 1 p.m. on the day before the respective race https://max.m-start.de. There is no entitlement to the admission of a late entry.

Team Managers' meeting

There will not be a meeting of the Team Managers. The Team Info is available for information.

Clothing

Members of the same team must compete in uniform clothing. In mixed races, the uniform clothing rule is not applied. Teams may compete with oar blades that are not the same colour within the team.

Award ceremony

The award ceremony will take place directly after each heat. Only the first-placed athletes will be honoured directly after their race at the victory pontoon. Due to the tight race schedule, the athletes will remain seated in their boats.

Before each award ceremony, the accreditation of the athletes will be checked.

In the Trophy races marked with T, places 1 to 3 will receive medals (gold, silver and bronze) and a prize. All Trophy races will be honoured on the stage in the festival area on the evenings of 28 and 29 July. For time see notice board.

Pontoons

There are two in and 2 out pontoons. Another 2 pontoons in the middle are only available for rental boats from our premium partner Filippi.

Team tents

Tents, which serve the teams' stay, can be set up in front of the closed grandstand in the designated areas free of charge after prior registration. A corresponding area will be allocated by the regatta management, there is no entitlement to a special place. Please contact the team info.

The preparation of meals is not permitted in these team tents! Electricity will not be provided.











Training times

On the training days:

- Official training times
 - \circ $\;$ Tuesday, 25 July 9:00 to 13:00 and 14:00 to 19:00 $\;$
 - \circ $\:$ Wednesday, 26 July 9:00 to 13:00 and 14:00 to 19:00 $\:$
- On training days, the water is also open outside these times from sunrise to sunset. No water rescue is present outside the official training times.

On the competition days:

- On 27 and 28 July, official training starts 30 minutes after the start of the last race and ends at 20:00. The water will be open until sunset. Before the first start and during the races, training is strictly prohibited on these days for safety reasons.
- On 29 and 30 July, training will not be possible all day for safety reasons.

Participation in training and races is principally at your own risk.

Crew Changes

Crew changes are possible up to four hours before the start time of the first division of the respective event under <u>https://max.m-start.de</u>. A maximum of only half of the rowers of a team may be changed. A crew change is not permitted if the age of the substituted rower would lower the average age of the original team by more than one year or would change the age category of the team. Deviation from the World Rowing Rules of Racing: Substitutes do not have to be members of the same club (or, in the case of racing teams, do not have to belong to one of the participating clubs).

Weighing

For the Lightweight events (MLW and MLM), "Rule 22 – Lightweights" and "Bye-Law to Rule 22 - Weighing of Lightweight Rowers" of the World Rowing Rules of Racing shall apply analogously.

The scales are in Block B in Hall 22. Please be sure to bring your accreditation with you to the weighing. A test weighing is possible there on Tuesday and Wednesday from 10:00 to 19:00 hrs.










Site plan














Traffic Rules

Traffics Rules - Training














Trafffic Rules - Racing
