Race distance: 1000m

Lanes: 6

Race intervals: 3 to 5 mins

### 2. Entry deadline

Wednesday, June 24, 2026, 18:00 hrs (CEST)

#### Please note:

**The MM/W (MIX) events will take place distributed over all four days. Entries for all mixed events must be submitted by the entry deadline. Late entries are possible.**

**If the maximum number of entries is reached, the deadline can be brought forward!**

Entries only via the online entry system.

**Important:** Like the entry process for World Rowing Masters Regattas since 2025, entries for the Euro Masters Regatta requires a World Rowing Masters Membership, which must be obtained before the entry deadline. Entries without a World Rowing Masters Membership can be created, but the entry must be completed before the entry deadline. This applies to both rowers and coxswains.

<https://masters.worldrowing.com>. This will make on-site accreditation much easier.

**Important:** The Organising Committee considers the Euro Masters Regatta as an event that unites people and athletes. However, we condemn the Russian war against Ukraine. We stand in solidarity with the Ukrainian people and especially with the Ukrainian rowing family in this international crisis. The organizing committee will therefore continue to prohibit the participation of Russian and Belarusian athletes and officials in this competition in 2026.

Late entries are accepted at <https://max.m-start.de> until 13:00 hrs (CEST) the day before the actual race. Entry fees in this case are adapted as follows: In this case, the regatta fees will be increased as follows: For events in the 1x, 2x and 2- boat classes, double the regatta fee will be charged; for the 4x, 4-, 4+ and 8+ boat classes, only a 25% surcharge will be applied. There is no entitlement to late entries. For Mixed events on Sunday, entries can be made at the regular entry fees.

Early registration: At the early registration deadline on 01 April 2026 the amount for the early entries is due by bank transfer or online payment. Early entries that are not paid for by the deadline will be charged with the regular entry fees.

Regular entries: At the entry deadline on 24 June 2026 18:00 hrs (CEST) the total amount of the entry fees incl. possible additional fees (excluding the early registration fees already paid) are due by bank transfer or online payment. If the regatta fees have not been received by the Organising Committee by 25 June 2026 18:00 (CEST), the teams will not be allowed to start. The regatta fees and costs for possible additional services are due, nevertheless. Payments on site are not possible (except for payments for late entries)!

Late entries: Entry fees for late entries can be paid by bank transfer or online payment or at the regatta office.

Online payment via PayPal. Wire transfer costs must be paid by the registrant, not the host. Entry fees will only be reimbursed for events that did not take place minus eventual wire transfer costs. Teams that have not paid their regatta fee in time are not allowed to start. During the regatta, bank transfers can be made as real-time transfers.

## 6. Additional regulations

### a) Boat rental

Rental boats will be offered. Further information can be found at our website from spring 2026. All boat rental at the regatta venue is reserved to the boat rental agencies authorized by the host.

### b) World Rowing Rules of Racing

The races shall be rowed according to the World Rowing Rules of Racing and related bye-laws. Deviating from this, a rower may compete in the "Young Masters" AA age category if he/she attains the age of 21 in 2026. Individuals whose age places them in the "Young Masters" AA category (age 21-26) may now compete in any age category where the average age of the boat falls within that specific age category. In general, the age that will be reached in 2026 applies for allocation to an age group.

Within an age category, a sorting by the year of birth is applied equivalent to a World Masters Regatta. The sorting by year of birth will be done at the draw considering all valid entries by the time of the draw. The sorting within an age category will be done backwards from the oldest to the youngest participant. Late entries that will come in after the draw will row in the heat with the youngest participants, not considering their year of birth. If scratches occur, the regatta committee reserves the right to depart from that rule.

### **Lightweights**

For the Masters lightweight events (MLW and MLM), “Rule 22 – Lightweights” und “Bye-Law to Rule 22 – Weighing of Lightweight Rowers” of the World Rowing Rules of Racing applies analogously. Lightweight single scullers may not weigh more than 72.5kg (men/MLM) and 59.0kg (women/MLW). Lightweight rowers shall be weighed wearing only their racing uniform not less than one hour and not more than two hours before their race time.

### **Coxswains**

The minimum weight of the coxswains for all races is 55 kg. Up to 15 kg short weight can be compensated by an additional weight. At the Euro Masters Regatta, coxswains do not have to be weighed before their race but will be randomly checked or selected by the Jury President or a delegate to be weighed immediately after getting out of the boat after their race. If, on inspection immediately after the race, the weight of a coxswain, together with the additional weight that the coxswain is required to carry in the boat during the race, is found to be less than the minimum weight prescribed in these rules, the team shall be excluded from the race.

Coxswains may be of either sex. They shall not be considered when determining the minimum age or the minimum average age.

### **Mixed races**

Mixed crews (MM/W) are crews where half of the crew excluding the coxswain shall be women and half shall be men.

### **Proof of age and accreditation**

Each regatta participant must prove their age during the regatta by means of their World Rowing Masters Membership. Alternatively, a copy of an official photo ID (passport, identity card, driving licence) may be presented.

Accreditation is available at the Service Centre, which eliminates the need to carry photo ID. The age of participants will be checked during the regatta. In addition, identity may be checked at any time during the regatta, especially at the award ceremony.

### **Clothing**

Members of the same crew shall compete wearing uniform clothing.

The regulation regarding uniform clothing does not apply for mixed crews. Teams may compete with oar blades that are not the same colour within the team.

### **Race divisions**

When the number of entries in an event exceeds the number of available racing lanes, the event will be divided into two or more finals. If an event’s age category has one entry only, this crew shall start in the next lower age category.

### **Substitutes**

Crew Changes are possible up to two hours before the start time of the first heat of the respective event at <https://max.m-start.de>. As a maximum, only half of the rowers of a crew may be substituted. Deviation from the World Rowing Rules of Racing: The substitutes do not have to be members of the same club (or, in the case of composite crews, do not have to belong to one of the clubs concerned). A substitute shall not be permitted if the age of the substituting rower would lower the average age of the original crew by more than one year or would change the age category of the team in such a way that the team would no longer be eligible to compete in the registered age category.

## **Withdrawals**

If a crew cannot or does not want to start in a race, the crew must withdraw its entry as soon as possible at <https://max.m-start.de>. For fairness reasons for the other crews in this race and for crews who want to participate instead by late entry, the withdrawal should take place until 13:00 hrs (CEST) of the day before the race, at the latest two hours before the start time of the first heat of the respective race.

## **Prioritization in case of schedule changes**

1. If necessary (e.g. due to weather conditions), races will either be postponed to a later time on the same day or to the next day if time is available. This may also result in breaks in the schedule being omitted or race intervals being shortened.
2. Races may start earlier than announced. The announcement must be made at least three (3) hours before the race or by 21:00 hrs the evening before if it is a morning race.
3. Races may also be postponed to a later day of the regatta if time permits.
4. Races can be cancelled completely on individual regatta days.
5. Individual regatta days can be cancelled completely.
6. The regatta as a whole may be cancelled.

Under no circumstances will races be rescheduled for a date later than 26 July 2026.

## **Anti-Doping**

It should be noted that doping controls are also possible at Masters regattas. The anti-doping regulations in the World Rowing Rule Book apply.

## **Health**

Each competitor shall be responsible for his or her own health and fitness.

### **c) Masters Trophy events for 1x, MM/W 2x and MM/W 4x**

**In 2026, corresponding trophy events will be held for all MM 1x and MW 1x races as well as all MM/W 2x and MM/W 4x events. The trophy events will all take place on Sunday. The trophy events will only take place if the respective qualifying races are held in more than one heat.**

*To participate in the Masters Trophy, rowers must have made an entry at <https://max.m-start.de> for the corresponding qualifying event and for the Masters Trophy by 18:00 hrs on the day before the qualifying event. There is a fee for entering Trophy events; the regular regatta fee for the respective boat class will be charged.*

Qualification for the Trophy events is as follows: The six fastest times from the heats of the corresponding underlying qualifying events in the same age group will be set.

If an event (in the respective age group) consists of only up to six participants, the Trophy event will be cancelled and the regatta fees paid for the Trophy event will be refunded. In the event of a missed qualification, the regatta fee for the Trophy will also be refunded. If a rower does not compete in their Trophy event, the regatta fee will not be refunded. The award ceremony will take place immediately after each Trophy event at the victory pontoon.

### **Details on the Masters Single Trophy "Jutta Deuschl"**

The results in the respective lightweight races of the same age group will also be considered for qualification. If lightweights qualify for the Masters Single Trophy, they will not be weighed for the Trophy event.

Participants can only qualify for the finals in the event of their own age group. Example: A 61-year-old rower can only qualify for the final in age group F, but not in age group E. The draw will take place two hours after the last heat of the respective race.

The Masters Single Trophy is named in honour of the former Vice President of Regatta München e.V. and German National Team rower Jutta Deuschl. Jutta was a founding board member of Regatta München e.V. and a passionate and ambitious Masters rower. She was instrumental in shaping the new format of the Euro Masters Regatta. Jutta died of cancer in January 2021 at the age of 47.

#### **Details on the Masters Double and Quadruple Trophy “Klaus Ulbrich”**

Crew changes are not possible after the underlying qualifying event and will result in the boat being excluded from the trophy event.

The Masters Double Trophy was named in honour of the former honorary member of Regatta München e.V. and honorary president of the Bavarian Rowing Association, Professor Klaus Ulbrich. A passionate rower, he was co-organiser of major international regattas in Munich and passed away in September 2025 at the age of 91.

#### **d) Catering**

There will be a variety of catering options available at the regatta centre.

#### **e) Accommodation**

Accommodation options are listed on the official website and can be booked directly by participants.

#### **f) Camping**

At the regatta centre, the camping site can be booked for a fee. The contingent is limited. Bookings can be made via our online registration system at <https://max.m-start.de>. Bookings must be made in advance. No more bookings will be accepted on site.

#### **g) Shuttle Service**

A shuttle bus service is available. The service is offered for a fee, and advance bookings can be made at <https://max.m-start.de>.

#### **h) Masters Party**

The Masters Party will take place on Saturday, 25 July 2026. More information will be available on the website in due time.

#### **i) Team tents**

Team tents can be set up in front of the grandstand and along the course at designated locations free of charge. As the available space is limited, pre-registration with details of the required area is necessary via our online registration portal at <https://max.m-start.de>. The preparation of hot food is not permitted in these tents. Please leave your team tent area clean.

Rental tents are available. Prices and detailed information will be published on the official website in due course.

#### **j) Safety notice**

On the whole venue, escape and emergency routes must be always kept free. Green areas must not be used to park vehicles or trailers. The paved area immediately in front of and behind the boathouses must be kept clear during the entire event. Open fire and the preparation of food using electric, gas, or charcoal devices is prohibited. Staying overnight in the boathouses (ground floor) is prohibited. In case of violations, an exclusion from the regatta may be considered.

#### **k) Parking**

During the entire regatta only drawing vehicles may enter the regatta venue to bring boat trailers in or pick them up. These drawing vehicles as well as all other vehicles must park at the grandstand parking of the Olympic Regatta Centre. There is a parking fee that applies to all vehicles. The parking

lot is operated externally and is subject to a fee. Multi-day parking permits can be booked via <https://max.m-start.de>.

**l) Liability & Force Majeure**

Claims arising from any damage to the event location or on the water cannot be asserted by the participants. The insurance of equipment and persons is the responsibility of the participants. The organizer assumes no liability of any kind.

In the event of cancellation due to force majeure (e.g. pandemic), the organizer accepts no liability for any costs incurred. The clubs/participants are not entitled to claim a refund of the regatta fees or reimbursement of expenses from the organizer and its regatta committee. This also applies if the regatta is cancelled/interrupted for compelling reasons or if individual races are cancelled.

**m) Photo and video recording**

During the regatta, photos and videos will be taken. Participants who do not agree to this must object at the regatta office before the event.
